RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (MMU) FROM TESCO SPECIALTY VEHICLES TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO PREVENTION & INFECTION CONTROL SERVICES FOR COVID-19 & OTHER EMERGING INFECTIOUS DISEASES (EO23 GRANT-EXPENSE NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000)

**WHEREAS**, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) receives funding through the Ohio Department of Health Enhanced Operation (EO23) grant to prevent and control the spread of COVID-19 and other emerging infectious disease (e.g., MPOX, measles); and

**WHEREAS**, FCPH intends to mobilize COVID-19 testing, infectious disease education, and mitigation efforts with a focus on vulnerable populations; and

**WHEREAS**, Tesco Specialty Vehicles has a mobile unit that allows FCPH to provide these public health testing, education, and mitigation services throughout Franklin County.
