RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (OEPA) FOR A MOSQUITO CONTROL GRANT FOR 2024 (REVENUE UP TO \$19,294)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) applied for and was awarded a Mosquito Control Grant from the Ohio EPA;

WHEREAS, this grant will enable FCPH to further protect human health and the environment by mitigating the potential for an outbreak of mosquito borne diseases; and

WHEREAS, this resolution supports the following Environmental Health Division Strategic Goals: Connect Environmental Health Work to Addressing Equity and Social Determinants of Health, Diversify Funding Streams, and addressing vector-borne disease.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to enter into a contract with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for a Mosquito Control Grant for 2024 (revenue up to \$19,294.00).
2. That the terms and form of the agreement shall be substantially similar to that which is attached hereto as Attachment A, which is hereby incorporated by reference.
