RESOLUTION TO ALLOW THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH COLUMBUS PUBLIC HEALTH FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF TIPPING FEES BY SCOTT'S LANDFILL (REVENUE)

WHEREAS, Scott's Landfill has a dual C&DD license issued by Franklin County Public Health ("FCPH") and Columbus Public Health ("CPH");

WHEREAS, Scott's Landfill has proposed a "Tipping Fee Distribution" Plan. This plan will allow the landfill to distribute "Tipping Fees" collected to both health departments at a percentage determined/calculated by the professional engineer, Bowser Morner;

WHEREAS, FCPH would like to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Columbus that identifies the percentages collected each month for the life of the landfill; and

WHEREAS, this resolution supports Environmental Health Division Strategic Goal #4 of sustainable funding.
