

RESOLUTION TO ALLOW THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER
TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
WITH COLUMBUS PUBLIC HEALTH FOR THE DISTRIBUTION
OF TIPPING FEES BY SCOTT'S LANDFILL (REVENUE)

WHEREAS, Scott's Landfill has a dual C&DD license issued by Franklin County Public Health ("FCPH") and Columbus Public Health ("CPH");

WHEREAS, Scott's Landfill has proposed a "Tipping Fee Distribution" Plan. This plan will allow the landfill to distribute "Tipping Fees" collected to both health departments at a percentage determined/calculated by the professional engineer, Bowser Morner;

WHEREAS, FCPH would like to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Columbus that identifies the percentages collected each month for the life of the landfill; and

WHEREAS, this resolution supports Environmental Health Division Strategic Goal #4 of sustainable funding.

Now, therefore, upon motion of Board Member _____, seconded by Board Member _____,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to enter into a memorandum of understanding with Columbus Public Health for the distribution of Tipping Fees from Scott's Landfill for the life of the landfill.
2. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
