WHEREAS, vaccinations are critical for safe guarding public health preventing the spread of infectious diseases, reducing the burden on healthcare systems, and protecting vulnerable populations; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) and Columbus Public Health (CPH) have immunization programs that carry vaccine which requires a temperature controlled environment and become unusable if their specified temperatures are not maintained; and

WHEREAS, both facilities have refrigerators and freezers that are capable of properly storing vaccine, and employ individuals who are familiar with vaccine storage, handling and accountability requirements; and

WHEREAS, this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) allows FCPH and CPH to remain prepared for unforeseen circumstances such as temperature fluctuations, power failures, and other emergencies concerning vaccines, which jeopardize their viability; and

WHEREAS, this is a precautionary step to avoid the loss or wastage of vaccines and necessary to maintain Vaccine For Children Status through the Ohio Department of Heath
