RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO HEALTH INFORMATION PARTNERSHIP TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CLINISYNC HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE THROUGH THE UNITE US CARE COORDINATION PLATFORM (EXPENSE NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000-FUNDED BY ODH EO23 Grant)

WHEREAS, The Ohio Health Information Partnership (OHIP) is a independent, nonprofit, neutral entity that developed the Clinisync Health Information Exchange (HIE) as a platform to electronically exchange patient health information with medical and social service providers to improve care coordination;

WHEREAS, Unite Us brings together healthcare providers, payers, governmental agencies, nonprofits and private sector entities through a cross sector collaboration software. This care coordination platform assists with identifying social needs in communities, manages enrollment of individuals in services and provides outcome data and analytics to drive future community investment;

WHEREAS, OHIP through the Clinisync HIE as entered into a master services agreement with Unite Us allowing healthcare providers, hospitals, and public health access to the proprietary Unite Us care coordination network at reduced cost

WHEREAS, participation in the HIE through the Unite Us platform aligns with the Collective Impact Alignment section as highlighted in the Franklin County Public Health Community Health Improvement Plan.

Now, therefore, upon motion of Board Member _____ and second by Board Member _____

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to enter into a contract with the Ohio Health Information Partnership to participate in the Clinisync Health Information Exchange through the Unite Us Care Coordination Platform (expense not to exceed \$50,000-funded by ODH EO23 grant).
2. This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
