RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FAIRFAX COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT FOR A TRAVEL STIPEND AND EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION FOR THEIR DISTRICT STANDARDIZATION OFFICER TO STANDARDIZE FRANKLIN COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH STAFF (EXPENSE OF \$5,010.26)

WHEREAS, the Fairfax County Health Department will send a District Standardization Officer (DSO) to Franklin County Public Health to Standardize James Smith to become a DSO to meet Standard 2 of the Food and Drug Administration ("FDA") Voluntarily Retail Standards and standardize our food inspection staff;

WHEREAS, the funds for the travel stipend and employee compensation will come from our National Environmental Health Association (NEHA) FDA Retail Flexible Funding Model (RFFM) grant;

WHEREAS, the Standardization process is to begin August 5, 2024 and end August 9, 2024; and

WHEREAS, this resolution supports Environmental Health Division Strategic Goal of connecting environmental health work to social determinants of health, creating equitable policies and practices diversifying funding.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Board of Health authorizes the Health Commissioner to enter into an agreement to pay a stipend to Fairfax County for travel expenses and employee compensation costs of their District Standardization Officer (Expense of \$5,010.26).
2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
