RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH COLUMBUS PUBLIC HEALTH TO PROVIDE IMMUNIZATION EDUCATION AND MONITORING AS PART OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH GET VACCINATED OHIO GRANT (REVENUE OF \$118,958.24)

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Health awarded a Get Vaccinated Ohio – Public Health Initiative grant to Columbus Public Health (CPH) to provide immunization education and monitoring;

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) is a sub grantee in the Get Vaccinated Ohio-Public Health Initiative grant;

WHEREAS, CPH and FCPH are authorized to enter into an agreement pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3709.282;

WHEREAS, this contract allows FCPH to provide needed immunization education and monitoring to health care providers to determine immunization rates and eventually improve vaccination rates of children and adolescents in the county. This contract allows FCPH to work closely and provide support to the school districts within FCPH jurisdiction (excluding CPH jurisdiction) to improve children and adolescent immunization rates; and

WHEREAS, this agreement directly aligns with Public Health Accreditation Board (PHAB) Domain 7, to contribute to an effective system that enables equitable access to the individual services and care needed to be healthy.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to enter into a contract with Columbus Public Health as a sub grantee on the Get Vaccinated Ohio – Public Health Initiative Grant awarded by the Ohio Department of Health (REVENUE OF \$118,958.24)
