RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO PROVIDE 317 VACCINES TO UNINSURED ADULTS IN FRANKLIN COUNTY (No Cost)

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) administers the Adult Immunization Program, which provides vaccines supplied by the federal government at no cost to local health departments serving uninsured or underinsured adults;

**WHEREAS**, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) is committed to promoting and protecting the health and well-being of all residents of Franklin County, particularly the underserved populations;

**WHEREAS**, the FCPH Immunization and School Health team operates under standing orders from the Medical Director to deliver immunization services to uninsured and underinsured adults in Franklin County;

**WHEREAS**, ODH supplies the necessary vaccines for these services, allowing FCPH to provide these critical immunization services; and

**WHEREAS**, this agreement aligns with Public Health Accreditation Board (PHAB) Domain 7, to contribute to an effective system that enables equitable access to the individual services and care needed to be healthy.
