

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (ODH) FOR FY2024-2025 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS (PHEP) CITIES READINESS INITIATIVE (CRI), GRANT JULY 1, 2024, TO JUNE 30, 2025. (REVENUE NOT TO EXCEED \$100,980.00 – CRI FUNDING);

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) provides grant funding to Franklin County Public Health for Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) Cities Readiness Initiative (CRI) grant; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health is responsible for designated areas of the County and is required by the Ohio Department of Health to perform the services of emergency preparedness planning, plan development and education; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health is authorized to enter into an agreement for Emergency Preparedness activities to best serve the residents of Franklin County both through real world events and trainings; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health oversees the Points of Dispensing (PODs) within the FCPH jurisdiction, in the event of a public health emergency and Medical Counter Measures (MCMs) are to be deployed within a designated timeline in collaboration with ODH; and

WHEREAS, this is the first year of a five year grant cycle for PHEP-CRI funding; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Preparedness program and activities aligns with Franklin County Public Health PHAB accreditation measurement 5.4;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH BOARD MEMBERS;
