RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT EXTENSION FROM THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF CITY AND COUNTY HEALTH OFFICIALS FOR THE PARTNERING FOR DISEASE FORECASTING AND ANALYTICS GRANT (NO COST EXTENSION)

WHEREAS, the National Association of City and County Health Officials (NACCHO) supports local health department efforts to develop public health policies and programs, ensuring communities have access to vital programs and services to protect them from disease and disaster; and

WHEREAS, NACCHO, with support from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Center for Forecasting and Outbreak Analytics, provides funding to enhance the capacity of local health departments to integrate forecasting and analytical tools into infectious disease outbreak planning and response at the local level; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) was selected by NACCHO as a demonstration site, with support from the CDC, to implement tools and methodologies that enable the department to proactively predict and analyze disease outbreaks, thereby improving public health response and mitigating the impact of infectious diseases; and

WHEREAS, deliverables include carrying out hands-on training, simulations, and exercises to increase decision-makers' capacity to translate analytic results into public health actions and policy development; and

WHEREAS, the grant funding extension will be through October 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, these deliverables align with Prevention & Wellness strategic goal to translate the health implications of identified trends and hot spots into program planning and development.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Board of Health authorizes the Health Commissioner to enter into a contract extension from the National Association of City and County Health Officials for the Partnering for Disease Forecasting and Analytics Grant. (No cost extension)
