

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZING AMENDED CONTRACTS WITH THE COMMUNITY HEALTH ACTION TEAMS (CHATs) FISCAL AGENTS TO AMEND THE CURRENT BUDGET TO INCLUDE ADMINISTRATION FEES. (TOTAL EXPENSE OF \$4,635; SOURCE OF FUNDING: CURRENT EO23 BUDGETED CONTRACTS).

**WHEREAS**, an amendment is needed for the request of fiscal agent administrative fees to be distributed from the awarded CHAT EO23 funds, to respective CHAT fiscal agents. Specific CHAT Fiscal Agent administrative fee requests are as follows:

- Hilliard CHAT (United Way of Central Ohio): 2% (\$500 of \$25,000 EO23 Funds)
- Eastside CHAT (United Way of Central Ohio): 2% (\$500 of \$25,000 EO23 Funds)
- Canal Winchester CHAT (United Way of Central Ohio): 2% (\$500 of \$25,000 EO23 Funds)
- Upper Arlington CHAT (Upper Arlington Community Foundation): 2.5% (\$625 of \$25,000 EO23 Funds)
- Prairie Township CHAT (Homes on the Hill): 10% (\$2,500 of \$25,000 EO23 funds)

**WHEREAS**, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) has been awarded funding from the Ohio Department of Health COVID-19 Enhanced Operations 2023 (EO23) grant for the purpose of supporting activities that increase community safety and emergency preparedness among residents in CHAT Communities focused on promoting emergency preparedness through resources kits and trainings, and informational resources through community outreach efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, The Canal Winchester, Hilliard, and Upper Arlington CHATs would host "Stop the Bleed" trainings, as well as create and distribute individual tourniquets and emergency preparedness kits. This will serve as a resource to keep the community safe in the event of an emergency or disaster.

**WHEREAS**, The Eastside, Prairie Township, and Westerville CHATs would create and distribute 2,000 COVID-19 Grab Bags. These bags would include hand sanitizer, a mask, disinfecting wipes, tissues, COVID-19 tests, and disposable thermometers. This resource would be distributed at health fairs and farmers markets, as well as to organizations serving high-risk populations. The intended outcome of these COVID-19 grab bags is for

them to serve as a resource to keeping the community safe and healthy from COVID-19.

**WHEREAS**, The Clinton Township CHAT would host a Community Safety Day event that would focus on accessibility to resources and socialization, which address various social determinants of health. This will be done to help improve health outcomes and safety promotion through distributing relevant materials that while providing an interactive experience for all age groups. The goal of this event would be to provide the local residents of Clinton Township with safety resources that mitigate the risks of preventable injuries, potential emergencies and reduce the spread of communicable diseases.

**WHEREAS**, alignment of this grant coincides with FCPH's Community Health Improvement Plan 2023-2026 – Basic Needs and Safety, specifically to increase the amount of evidence-based prevention and education supports and services occurring in the community. Along with emergency preparedness methods and resources towards overall community wellbeing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS.

1. That the Board of Health authorizes the Health Commissioner to enter into contracts with the Upper Arlington Community Foundation (Upper Arlington CHAT), Homes on the Hill (Prairie Township CHAT), and United Way of Central Ohio (Hilliard CHAT, Eastside CHAT, Canal Winchester CHAT) as CHAT fiscal agents, and to include administrative fees. (Total expense of \$4,625; Source of funding: Current EO23 budgeted contractual funds).
2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
