

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDED CONTRACTS WITH THE COMMUNITY HEALTH ACTION TEAMS (CHATs) FISCAL AGENTS TO AMEND THE CURRENT BUDGET TO INCLUDE ADMINISTRATION FEES. (TOTAL EXPENSE OF \$1,528.88; SOURCE OF FUNDING: CURENT ARPA BUDGETED CONTRACTS).

WHEREAS, an amendment is needed for the request of fiscal agent administrative fees to be distributed from the current awarded CHAT ARPA funds, to respective CHAT fiscal agents. This is to support fiscal agent ordering processing and other tasks related to CHAT projects and initiatives.

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) has been awarded funding from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) for the purpose of

supporting activities that increase community wellness and empowerment among residents in CHAT Communities focused on promoting mental health awareness and support, cancer and suicide prevention, food, health eating, and active living resources, along with general community health education and outreach; and

WHEREAS, Canal Winchester and Eastside CHATs would provide high demand service to underserved populations with purchasing items to prepare hygiene kits. These would be distributed to underserved populations that may have barriers that impact their personal hygiene, such as experiencing homelessness, childhood negligence, and or limited access to personal resources; and

WHEREAS, Hillard and Upper Arlington CHATS would focus on mindfulness activities to included development and printing of signage in local school and or parks that promote mental health mindfulness and resources. It will help decrease stigma surrounding mental health, and increases mental health awareness and education; and

WHEREAS, Westerville CHAT would purchase sunscreen and sunscreen dispensers for high traffic areas in Westerville. This is to promote skin cancer prevention as identified as type of cancer that effectives the Westerville community; and

WHEREAS, Prairie Township CHAT would host a senior resource fair and create and provide welcome kits. It would help increase awareness and access to community resources available to older adults and provide education on relevant health topics; and

WHEREAS, Clinton Township CHAT would focus on various community events that focus on anti-violence, social bonding and education. It would provide education on how to avoid becoming a victim of crime and provide hands on self-defense training.

WHEREAS, the alignment of this grant coincides with FCPH's Community Health Improvement Plan 2023-2026 – Basic Needs, specifically to increase the amount of evidence-based prevention and education support and services occurring in the community.

Now, therefore, upon motion of Board Member_____, seconded by Board Member_____;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS.

1. That the Board of Health authorizes the Health Commissioner to enter into contracts with the Upper Arlington Community Foundation (Upper Arlington CHAT), Homes on the Hill (Prairie Township CHAT), and United Way of Central Ohio (Hilliard CHAT, Eastside CHAT, Canal Winchester CHAT) as CHAT fiscal agents, and to include administrative fees. (Total expense of \$1,528.88; source of funding: Current ARPA budgeted contractual funds).
2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
