

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY NISONGER CENTER TO SERVE AS A SUB-CONTRACTING AGENCY AND PROVIDE LINKAGE TO CARE SERVICES FOR FRANKLIN COUNTY RESIDENTS. (REVENUE OF \$100,000.00. FUNDING SOURCE: CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION (CDC)).

WHEREAS, In 2022, the "Ohio Disability and Health LinkAGES Partnership: Linking individuals to achieve greater equity in services" grant, the Ohio State University (OSU) Nisonger Center was awarded funding by the CDC; and

WHEREAS, The Ohio State University Nisonger Center seeks to contract with Franklin County Public Health's (FCPH) Care Coordination program to provide Community Health Worker (CHW) support to residents with an intellectual or developmental disability; and

WHEREAS, FCPH CHWs will work closely with OSU Nisonger Center to provide services to screen, enroll and retain residents to mitigate risks and connect residents to medical, behavioral, and social service support; and

WHEREAS, FCPH will provide quarterly reports to OSU Nisonger Center of program data, key successes and barriers; and

WHEREAS, this grant aligns with PHAB Domains 4.1.1 (Foster cross-sector collaboration to advance equity), and 4.1.3 (Engage with community members to address public health issues and promote health), and the FCPH's Community Health Improvement Plan priority area Basic Needs.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the Health Commissioner is authorized to enter into a contract agreement with the Ohio State University Nisonger Center for to serve as a sub-contracting agency and provide linkage to care services for Franklin County residents. (Revenue of \$100,000.00)
