

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH UNITED WAY OF CENTRAL OHIO, TO SERVE AS THE FISCAL AGENT FOR THE HILLIARD COMMUNITY HEALTH ACTION TEAM (CHAT) (TOTAL EXPENSE OF \$11,325.00; SOURCE OF FUNDING: ARPA FUNDS).

WHEREAS, an amendment is needed for the Fiscal Agent representing the Hilliard CHAT. Previously Cross Creek Civic Association, was identified as the fiscal agent with the updated change to be United Way of Central Ohio.

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) has been awarded funding from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) for the purpose of supporting activities that increase community wellness and empowerment among residents in CHAT Communities focused on promoting mental health awareness and support, cancer and suicide prevention, and health education and outreach; and

WHEREAS, the Hilliard CHAT will focus on mindfulness activities to include the development and printing of signage in local schools and or parks that promote mental health mindfulness and resources. It will help decrease the stigma surrounding mental health, increase mental health awareness and education; and

WHEREAS, the alignment of this grant coincides with FCPH's Community Health Improvement Plan 2023-2026 – Basic Needs and Mental Health and Addiction, specifically to increase the amount of evidence-based prevention and education support and services occurring in the community.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS.

1. That the Board of Health authorizes the Health Commissioner to enter a contract with United Way of Central Ohio to serve as the fiscal agent for the Hilliard CHAT ARPA funds (Not to Exceed \$11,325.00).
