RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE SCHEDULE
OF FEES FOR TATTOOING AND BODY PIERCING
BUSINESSES FOR THE 2025 OPERATING/APPROVAL YEAR

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 3730.03 and 3709.09 of the Ohio Revised Code and Section 3701-09-03 of the Ohio Administrative Code, the Board has the authority to set fees for tattooing and body piercing businesses ("Body Art");

WHEREAS, the Environmental Health Division, in collaboration with the Fiscal Division, performed the cost methodology based on 2023 data to establish fees for the 2025 operating/approval year; and

WHEREAS, this resolution supports Environmental Health Division Strategic Goal #4 of sustainable funding.

Now, therefore, upon motion of Board Member _____, seconded by Board Member _____.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, BOARD MEMBERS;

1. That the body art program fees for the 2025 operating/approval year are adopted effective ten days from the date of the first publication in accordance with Section 3709.09(E).
2. That the Board directed the Health Commissioner to notify each person or government entity holding a body art license approval of the proposed fee increases and their opportunity to attend a public hearing on September 10, 2024.
3. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
