RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH THE GORDON FLESCH COMPANY FOR REPLACEMENT COPIERS and MAINTENANCE AGREEMENTS IN THE PREVENTION AND WELLNESS DIVISION (EXPENSE NOT TO EXCEED \$32,408.28 LEASE COSTS)

**WHEREAS**, the Prevention and Wellness division of Franklin County Public Health has 2 printers utilized by Prevention and Wellness staff on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor division area and on the 1<sup>st</sup> Floor immunization clinic area for various division needs.

**WHEREAS**, the leases on the current equipment are nearing expiration; and;

**WHEREAS**, The Gordon Flesch Company can provide the replacement devices necessary for staff use utilizing NASPO contract pricing; and

**WHEREAS**, The Gordon Flesch Company can provide toner inclusive maintenance for both devices utilizing State Term contract pricing for both black and white and color copies.
